



New Clark County Stormwater Requirements

Clark County is now requiring additional documentation with grading/site plan submittals. These additional documents are outlined in section 3.5.1 of the "Las Vegas Construction Site Best Management Practices Guidance Manual."

The Clark County Regional Flood Control District and the Las Vegas Valley Stormwater Quality Management Committee



developed the manual to assist members of the public involved in planning, designing and imple-

menting construction activities with requirements set forth in the **Nevada Stormwater General Permit for Construction Activities**.

Also, fees will soon be assessed in conjunction with a grading permit for the purposes of stormwater inspections, which are conducted by Development Services' building inspectors. The Board of County Commissioners must approve **proposed changes**

to the **Building Administrative Code**, including new language pertaining to these fees, before stormwater inspection fees may be assessed.

The updated Building Administrative Code will go before the County Commission for adoption later this summer.

Clark County Building Code Changes Sought

Clark County Development Services is proposing changes to the **Clark County Building Administrative Code**. These changes will include: fee increases, annual facility permit provisions and storm-water run off provisions.

Development Services is seeking citizen comments during this process. After the current draft is updated, it will be posted to the county website:

TMCC Announced Classes For July

8 Hour Hazardous Waste Operations Refresher -

Prerequisite: 40 hour-HAZ-WOPER certification. If you are certified to work with hazardous waste, you can comply with the annual training requirements set by OSHA's 29 CFR 1910.120 standard by taking this class. Learn about new legislation, the nine hazard classes and waste classifications, hazardous waste chemistry, the hazards of Lab Packs, the limitations of personal protective equipment and more. If you have a current medical clearance and your own air purifying respirator, take the opportunity to receive



your annual fit testing for no additional fee. You must provide a copy of your current certification to attend. The class will be on **July 20** at the IGT Applied Technology Center. Cost is \$165.

Forklift Safety Training -

Prerequisite: Must be at least 18 years old to register. Regardless if you're a novice or an experienced operator,

you'll find that this course will help you further develop driving skills. Learn safe operation of all forklift styles, such as sit-down, stand-up, rider pallet jack, reach trucks and order-pickers. In addition, find out about the stability triangle, load safety, the proper steps for completing a daily inspection and more. Classes will be on **July 11** or **July 25** at the TMCC IGT Applied Technology Center. Cost is \$79.
