**STATE CONTRACTORS' BOARD**

MINUTES OF THE MEETING  
APRIL 14, 1999

The meeting of the State Contractors' Board was called to order by Licensing Administrator, Nancy Mathias at 9:10 a.m., Wednesday, April 14, 1999, State Contractors Board, Reno, Nevada. Exhibit A is the Meeting Agenda.

PRESENT FOR THE MEETING:

The purpose of the meeting was to hear a proposed regulation change to NAC 624.130

Ms. Mathias stated the hearing notice had been posted in compliance with NRS 233B, the open meeting law, on March 10, 1999, at the Las Vegas City Hall, Sawyer City Building, Clark County Library, Washoe County Court House, Washoe County Library, Reno City Hall, and in each Board office, Las Vegas and Reno.

A workshop to solicit comment on the proposed amendment had been held on February 23, 1999 at the office of the board, 4220 South Maryland Parkway, Building D, Broad Room, Las Vegas, Nevada.

The regulation amends NAC 624.130 (Fees) by increasing fees per Exhibit B, the proposed regulation. The proposed fee increases would be applicable to the following:

- The fee to issue a duplicate license.
- The fee to issue a duplicate identification card.
- The fee to consider a change in the name of the licensee.
- The fee to consider an application for an increase in the monetary limit for a single project.
- To supply a report containing information regarding not more than 500 current licensees.
- To supply a report containing information regarding more than 500 current licensees.
- To consider a permanent increase or decrease in a licensee's monetary limit.
- To consider a change of the qualified person or corporate officer on a license.
- To consider a request to broaden a license to include a classification or subclassification not currently held.
- To increase the fee to renew a license.
- To put in place the fee to administer a cash bond account if the licensee currently holds a cash bond or subsequently posts one.
- To increase the fee to issue a new license.

All other fees would remain the same.

The time was now 9:15 a.m. The meeting time had been posted for 9:00 a.m., this date.

PUBLIC COMMENT

No one from the general public was present to comment either for or against the proposed change.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned by Ms. Mathias at 9:15 a.m.
