7th ANNUAL MISSION COOL OFF RECIPIENTS RECEIVE NEW AIR CONDITIONERS

HENDERSON, Nev. – The Nevada State Contractors Board (NSCB) and Southern Nevada Air Conditioning Refrigeration Service Contractors Association (SNARSCA) are pleased to announce that three households received new air conditioners for the 7th Annual Mission Cool Off program. Air conditioning units were replaced for *free* by SNARSCA volunteers.

The program was limited to the first 100 applications received from Jan. 19 – Feb. 29, 2012. Selections were made by NSCB and SNARSCA representatives, based upon a family's special circumstances or need.
