CONTRACTORS BOARD DISCIPLINES CONTRACTORS

HENDERSON and RENO, Nev. – The Nevada State Contractors Board took action against several licensed contractors for violations of Nevada Revised Statutes Chapter 624 during its November 13 hearing in Henderson.

A.A.C.A., LLC, dba Mr. Rooter Plumbing, license number 73696 (plumbing), based out of Las Vegas, Nev., was found in violation for disregarding state industrial insurance laws. Licensee was fined \$500 and assessed investigative costs. Failure to pay will result in the license being suspended.

Nicco Construction, LLC, license numbers 65339 (general building) and 68214 (low-voltage), based out of Las Vegas, Nev., was found in violation for failure to include the license number or monetary limit on a bid or contract and disregard of the state's building laws. Licensee was fined \$1,100 and assessed investigative costs. Failure to pay will result in the licenses being suspended.

Custom Tile and Stone, Inc., dba Pounders Custom Floors, license number 62184 (tiling), based out of Las Vegas, Nev., was found in violation for accepting a bid from an unlicensed person, acting in the capacity of a contractor beyond the scope of the license, and failure to establish financial responsibility. Licensee was fined \$1,500 and assessed investigative costs. Failure to pay will result in the license being suspended.

M.R.I. Solar, LLC, license number 76875 (water heating), based out of Henderson, Nev., was found in violation for failure to respond to a written request from the Board, bidding or contracting for a construction contract in excess of the limit placed on the license, failure to keep in place a bond or cash deposit, and failure to establish financial responsibility. The license was revoked. Licensee was fined \$4,500 and assessed investigative costs.

Ability Air Conditioning, Inc., license number 68391 (refrigeration and air conditioning), **Re-New Tech, Inc., dba Efficient Air Conditioning**, license number 69445 (refrigeration and air conditioning) and **Re-New Tech, Inc., dba Roof Repair Experts**, license number 70495 (roofing and siding), based out of Henderson, Nev., was found in violation for substandard workmanship, failure to take appropriate corrective action, failure to include Residential Recovery Fund information on a contract or proposal, disregard of the state's building laws, failure to establish financial responsibility and failure to keep in force a bond or cash deposit. Ability Air Conditioning, license number 68391, was voluntarily surrendered. Licensee was fined \$2,850 and assessed investigative costs.

The Nevada State Contractors Board is committed to protecting the public's health, safety, and welfare through licensing and regulation of the construction industry. Under Nevada Revised Statutes, a licensee is subject to disciplinary action by the Board for failure to comply with the requirements of the laws or regulations governing contractors. Violations may result in Board action against the contractor's license. The State Contractors Board has the power to regulate contractors and discipline licensees who violate NRS 624. Disciplinary action may consist of a fine of up to \$10,000 per offense, order corrective action, suspension, revocation or other action.
