CONTRACTORS BOARD SUMMARILY SUSPENDS ONE LICENSE; ISSUES \$18,000 FINE AGAINST ANOTHER

LAS VEGAS and RENO, NEV. – The Nevada State Contractors Board took disciplinary action against licensed contractors for violations of Nevada Revised Statutes Chapter 624 during its March hearings, including placing two licenses on summary suspension and issuing fines totaling \$23,000.

Under Nevada Revised Statutes, a licensee is subject to disciplinary action by the Board for failure to comply with the requirements of the laws or regulations governing contractors. Violations may result in Board action against the contractor's license. The State Contractors Board has the power to regulate contractors and discipline licensees who violate NRS 624. Disciplinary action may consist of a fine, order corrective action, suspension, revocation or other action.
